Magician Lake Boat Density

Boat Density = peak weekend power boat use (10% of available power boats or 100.5 boats) divided by
 usable water acreage (estimated at 80% of total acres or 398 acres) = 3.964 acres per boat

Recommended boat density is 20 acres per power boat (Wis., Minn., and Ind. studies)

Recommended power boats at any one time for Magician Lake is (398 acres divided by 20 acres) = 20 power boats
 (July 4th Day weekend observations estimated that 40-50 powerboats were on the lake at peak usage time (mid-afternoons))

Subareas of lake

Rainbow Park - East end of lake between Polk Properties and Gilmore Beach includes Rainbow Park Subdivision
 Gilmore/Gregory Beach - East end of lake in Turtle Bay includes both subdivisions
 Maple Island - West end of lake includes all cottages on Island beyond bridge to island.
 Southwest Bay - Includes cottages from Maple Island bridge around bay (Curren's Subdivision) and cottages around Midway Marine area
 including two canals in far southwest part of bay, stops at Log House on west end of lake
 Southshore - begins at Maple Island bridge and goes east (Curren's Beach area) and includes Polk Properties including canal

Northwestshore - begins at Log House and includes Jones Subdivision and northwest shore to Public Access Point

Islands - Includes all cottages on Hemlock and Rattlesnake Islands
